Southland/Mole Joint Venture (SMJV) and the City and County of Honolulu wishes to invite you to a public information meeting regarding a noise variance application for the Kaneohe/Kailua Tunnel Project, City and County of Honolulu Job No. W11-12.

The proposed work during the extended hours will include preparation for and installation of tunnel lining pipe, backfill for the tunnel lining pipe, as well as mobilization and demobilization of major equipment components utilized on the site. The intent of this work is to expedite construction schedules for the Project.

Night work and extended work hours are proposed to reduce time impacts to the Project and allow construction activities to be maintained 24 hours per day 6 days per week. This request for a noise variance will supplement the current construction hours.

Southland/Mole Joint Venture will continue to mitigate vehicular traffic during the start time and end time of the scheduled school days. Large material deliveries will be limited to daytime hours.

All construction work other than scheduled deliveries of material and equipment to the project site will be entirely inside the confines of the project site. Construction on the project is expected to occur from May of 2016 until February of 2017.

At the meeting, we will be presenting the project scope, objectives, schedule, and potential impacts to the community. We would also like to present the opportunity for the residents to ask

questions and express any comments and concerns you may have about the noise variance request. Although some minor inconveniences may be unavoidable, our goal is to work with the community to minimize and/or mitigate these and shorten the duration of the project. SMJV requests your patience and understanding of our efforts to complete these extremely important additions and upgrades to the Kaneohe/Kailua Treatment facilities and your neighborhoods.

Any questions you may have will be addressed by project personnel at the scheduled meeting.
